WHITEHORSE, June 1, 2016 – As incoming Chair of the Council of the Federation, Yukon Premier Darrell Pasloski will host the 2016 Summer Meeting of Canada's Premiers July 20 to 22 at the Kwanlin Dün Cultural Centre (KDCC) in Whitehorse.
